Picture this: 10's of thousands of rowdy Dodgers fans going into and out of Chavez ravine on boxes on a string over the 100 freeway? Additionally, Aerial Rapid Transit Technologies, is a partnership formed by McCourt, funded EIR and preliminary design process. Last year, McCourt Global gifted the project to a new entity, known as Zero Emission Technologies. ZET would be responsible for building, financing and operating the gondola. He doesn't care about the traffic or the gondola. He wants the gondola as a biut of marketing flare for his totally unaffordable residential development - ala The Grove or the Americana.
