

PUBLIC WORKS COMMITTEE REPORT relative to the use of Rapid Micro-Trenching in accordance with requirements established by the City Engineer and requiring a Street Damage Restoration Fee (SDRF) payment matching that of regular Micro-Trenching.

Recommendation for Council action:

REQUEST that the City Attorney prepare and present an ordinance authorizing the use of Rapid Micro-Trenching in accordance with requirements established by the City Engineer and requiring an SDRF payment matching that of regular Micro-Trenching.
