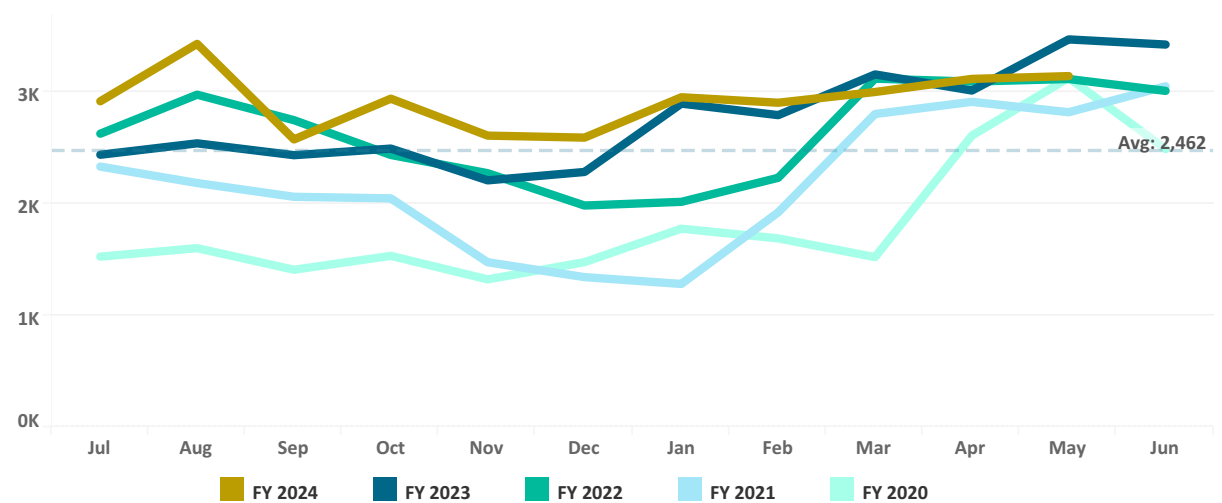

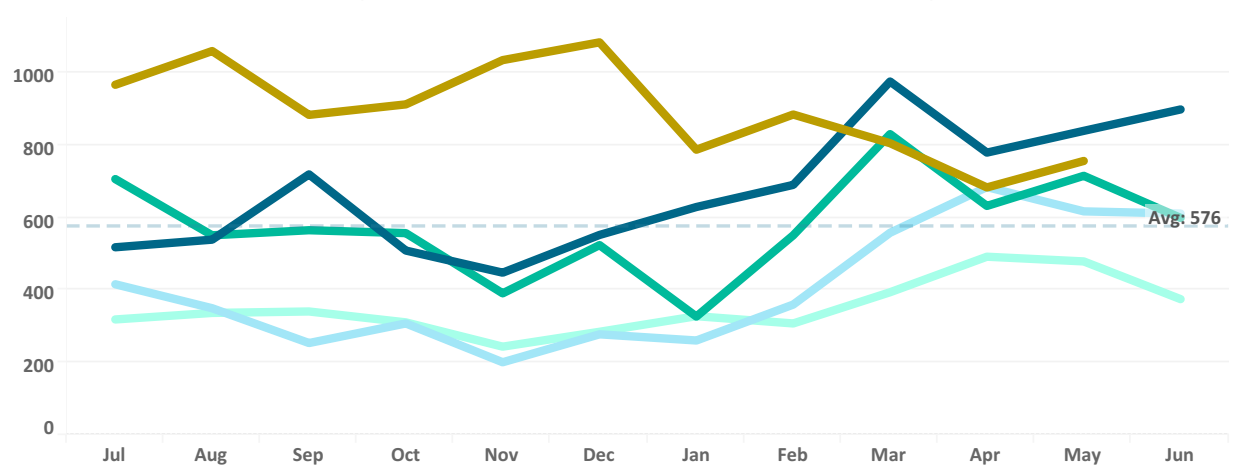

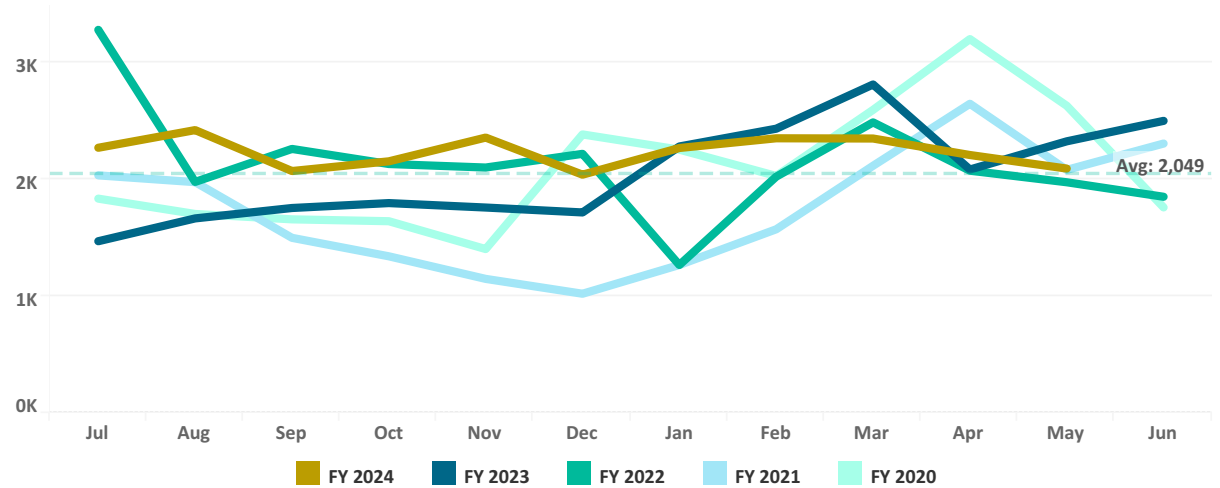

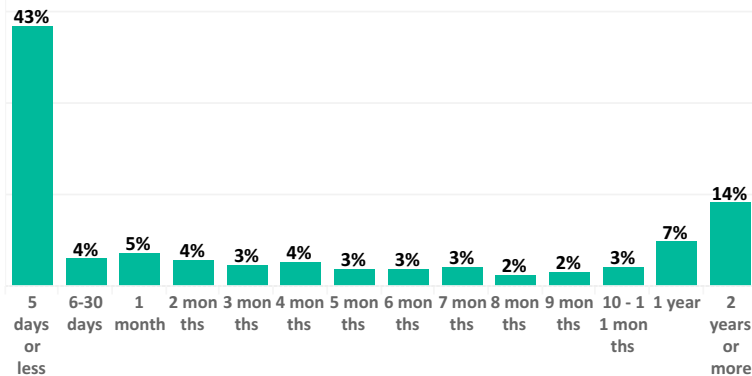

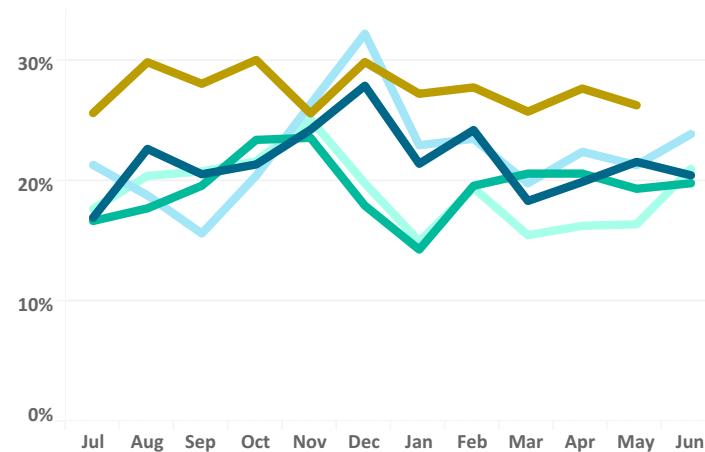
Interim Housing Enrollments

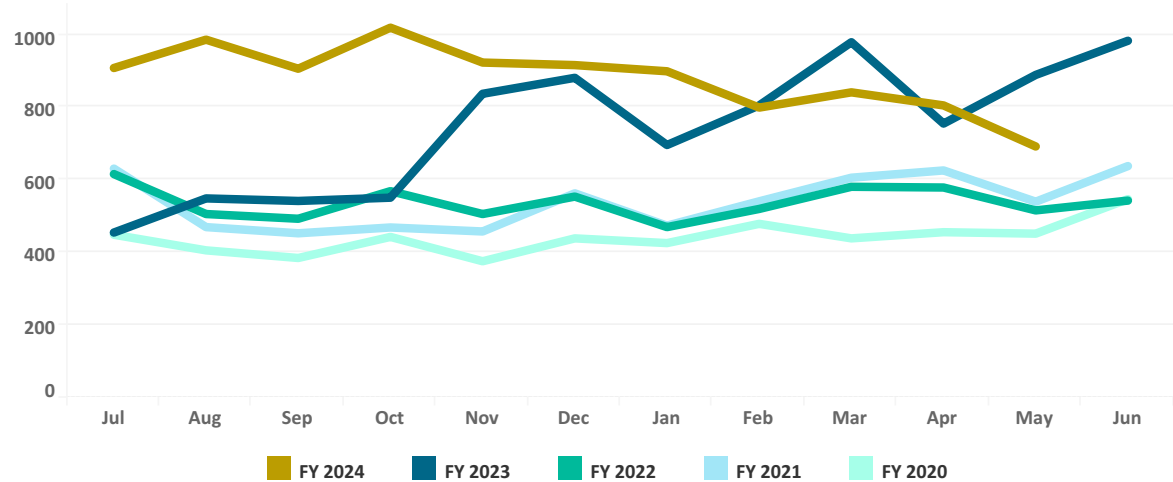

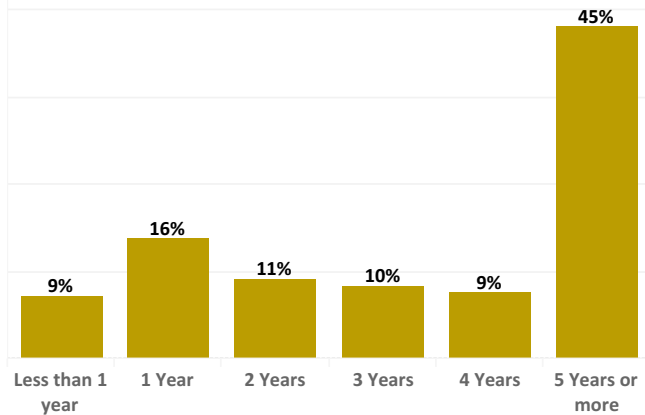
