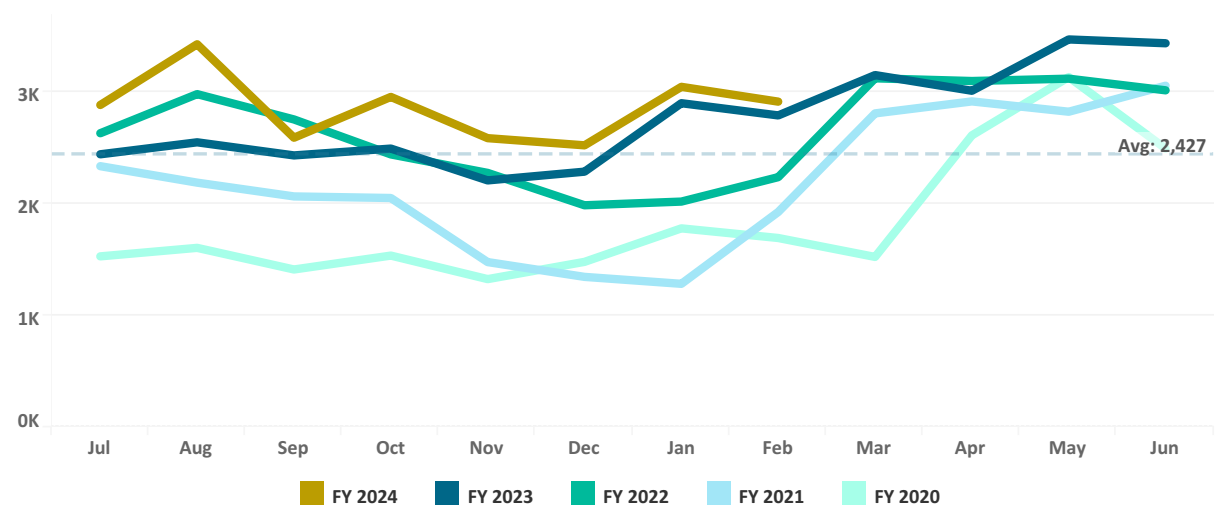

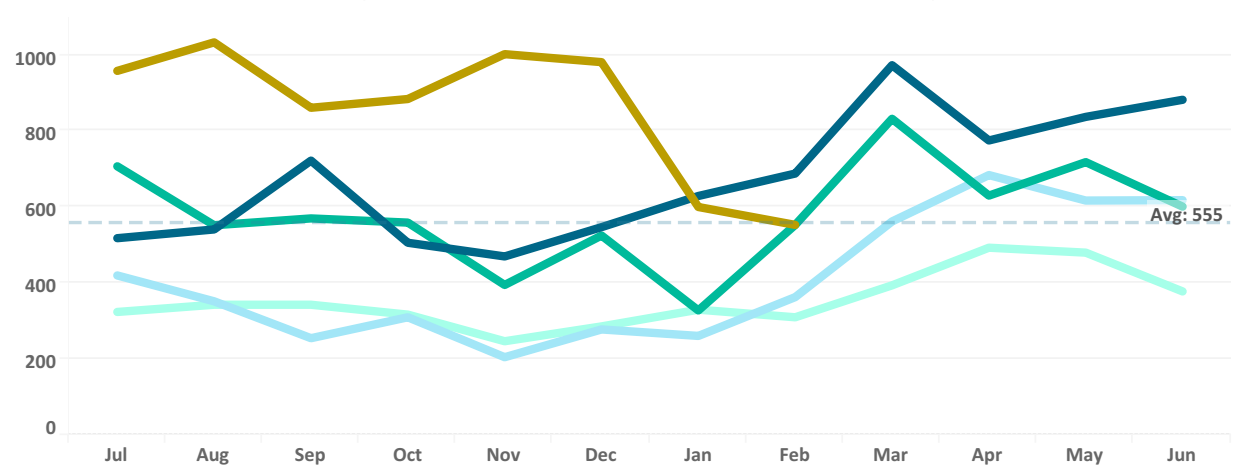

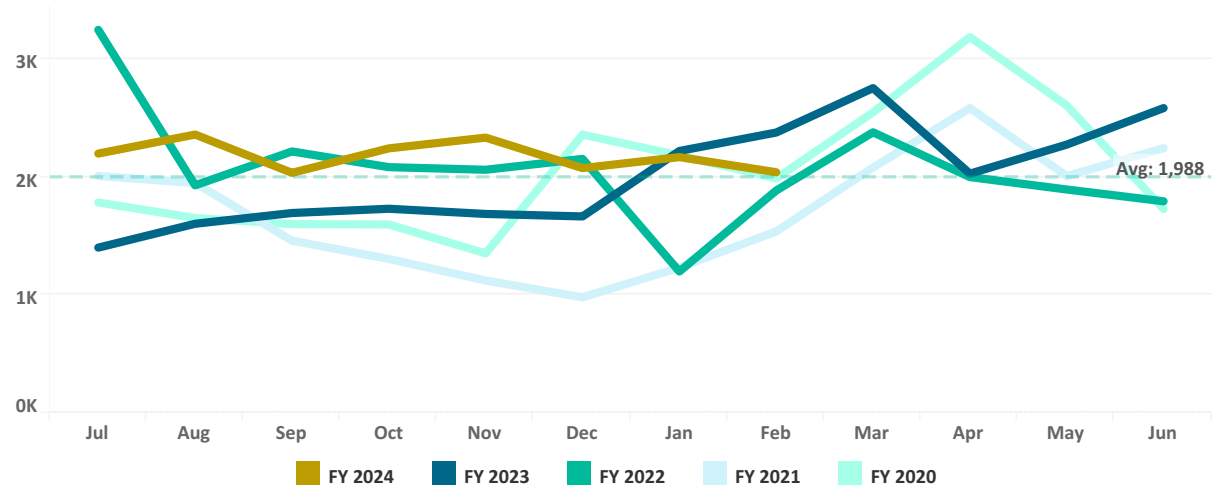

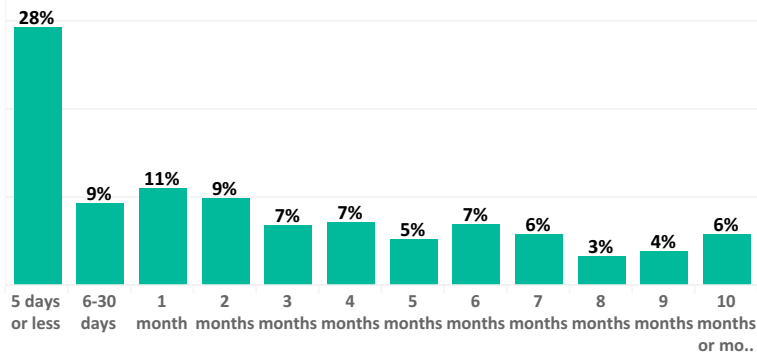

Interim Housing Enrollments

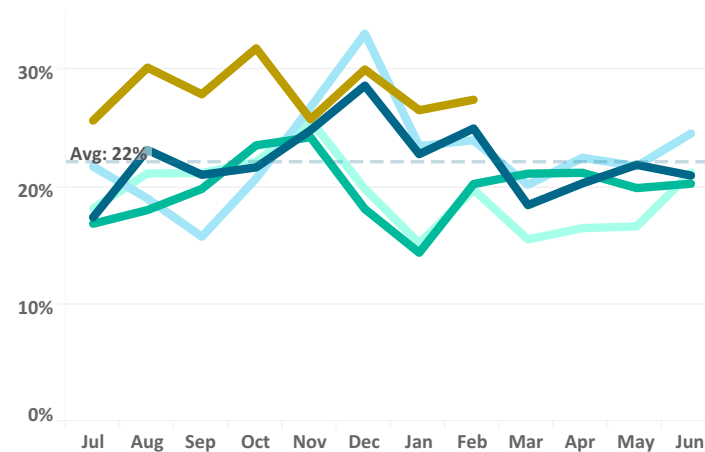


Length of Stay for Households Currently in Interim Housing

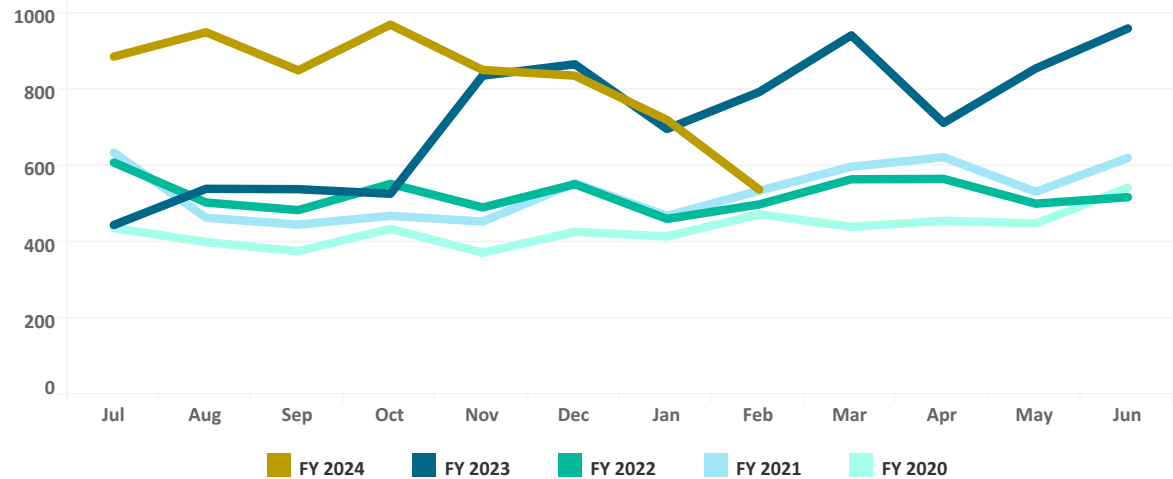

Households Housed by Program

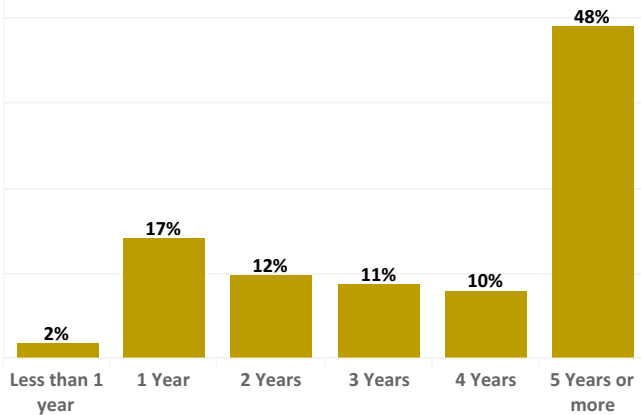
