HOUSING AND HOMELESSNESS COMMITTEE REPORT relative to instructing the City Administrative Officer (CAO) to report on the total amount of investments the City made on homeless programs and services related to Project Roomkey during COVID-19, that the City anticipated would be reimbursed by Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA).

Recommendations for Council action, pursuant to Motion (Rodriguez - Blumenfield):

- INSTRUCT the CAO to report to Council on the total amount of investments the City made on homeless programs and services related to Project Roomkey during COVID-19, including Reserve Fund loans, that the City anticipated would be reimbursed by FEMA and include the amount that has already been reimbursed by FEMA and the reimbursement amount the City is awaiting and any shortfalls between the two amounts.
- 2. INSTRUCT the CAO to report to Council on how the lack of reimbursement could affect the future City budget if the City does not receive the full anticipated reimbursement amount.

<u>Fiscal Impact Statement</u>: Neither the City Administrative Officer nor the Chief Legislative Analyst has completed a financial analysis of this report.
