**DISCUSSION**

This donation will provide two police service dogs for Metropolitan Division’s K-9 Platoon and allow for the replacement of dogs that have retired out of the program due to age-related physical and mental deterioration. Approval of this donation will support the K-9 Platoon to assist field and detective operations effectively with police service dogs performing at Platoon standards.


