MOTION

The Athens Services Community Benefits Trust Fund provides funding for health care, environmental, and transportation projects, programs, and services in the Sun Valley, Shadow Hills, Stonehurst, La Tuna Canyon, and nearby neighborhoods of Council Districts 2, 6, and 7. The Whitsett hillside slope area located on Whitsett Avenue between Sherman Way and Saticoy Avenue has become an attractive area for individuals who trespass and deface public and private property, which has resulted in damage to the habitat, defacement of the area and other related issues. In order to help beautify and restore the area, and eliminate the litter and graffiti problem, the City should invest in security lighting, fencing, irrigation repair and securing the water source.

I THEREFORE MOVE that \$86,174 from the Council District 2 portion of the Athens Services Community Benefits Trust Fund No. 56W-14 be transferred / appropriated to the below listed Accounts and in the amounts specified in the General Services Fund No. 100-40, for security lighting and improvements to help eliminate and prevent graffiti, litter and vandalism for the Whitsett Slope Beautification Project:
