

WHEREAS, Kiewit Infrastructure West Company (Kiewit) was awarded Agreement No. 47525 by the Los Angeles Department of Water and Power (LADWP) Board of Commissioners (Board) on August 27, 2019, for Progressive Design-Build services for the San Fernando Groundwater Basin Remediation Project for the design and construction of the Tujunga Well Field Response Action Treatment Facility and the North Hollywood Central Response Action Treatment Facility; and

WHEREAS, Amendment No. 1 was approved by the City Council on January 26, 2021, to increase the Agreement amount by \$87,000,000, from \$408,000,000 to \$495,000,000, due to increased costs not identified during conceptual design; and

WHEREAS, Amendment No. 2 was approved by the City Council on September 10, 2024 to extend the term of the Agreement due to procurement challenges during the COVID-19 Pandemic and to retain Kiewit's services until the facilities were commissioned; and

WHEREAS, due to delays in the permitting process of the Tujunga Well Field Response Action Treatment Facility, it is necessary to extend the term of the Agreement to retain Kiewit's services until the facility's commissioning is complete; and

WHEREAS, LADWP has determined that it is necessary to increase the contract term by one (1) year totaling seven (7) which exceeds the total contract time period set by ordinance, and in accordance with the City Charter Section 373, City Council approval is required.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that Amendment No. 3 to Agreement No. 47525 is approved;

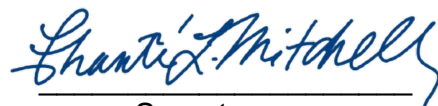
BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the contract term will end on September 08, 2026.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the President or Vice President, or the General Manager, or such person as the General Manager shall designate in writing, and the Secretary, Assistant Secretary, or the Acting Secretary of the Board are hereby authorized and directed to execute said Amendment No. 3 on behalf of LADWP.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Chief Accounting Employee of the LADWP, upon proper certification, is authorized and directed to draw demands on the Water Revenue Fund, in accordance with the revised budget and terms of this Amendment No. 3 to Agreement No. 47525 and this Resolution.
