

RESOLUTION

A RESOLUTION OF THE LOS ANGELES CITY COUNCIL REQUESTING THE LOS ANGELES COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS TO AUTHORIZE THE CONSOLIDATION OF THE CITY OF LOS ANGELES PRIMARY NOMINATING ELECTION AND A GENERAL MUNICIPAL ELECTION, IF NECESSARY, WITH THE STATE PRIMARY ELECTION TO BE HELD ON MARCH 5, 2024 AND THE STATE GENERAL ELECTION TO BE HELD ON NOVEMBER 5, 2024

WHEREAS, the Council of the City of Los Angeles has called, a Primary Nominating Election to be held on Tuesday, March 5, 2024 and a General Municipal Election to be held, if necessary, on Tuesday, November 5, 2024, consistent with the City Charter; and

WHEREAS, the City's Primary Nominating Election will be held in the City of Los Angeles to elect candidates for offices of Member of the City Council for Districts 2, 4, 6, 8, 10, 12, and 14; and

WHEREAS, the City's Primary Nominating Election also will be held in the Los Angeles Unified School District to elect candidates for the offices of Member of the Board of Education for Districts 1, 3, 5 and 7; and

WHEREAS, the Council of the City of Los Angeles requests that the City's Primary Nominating Election be consolidated with the State Primary Election.

WHEREAS, the Council of the City of Los Angeles requests that the City's General Municipal Election, if applicable, be consolidated with the State General Election.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED:

Section 1. That the Council of the City of Los Angeles respectfully requests the Board of Supervisors of the County of Los Angeles to consent and agree to the consolidation of the City's Primary Nominating and General Municipal Elections, including the elections for offices of the City of Los Angeles and Los Angeles Unified School District described in this Resolution, with the State Primary Election to be held on March 5, 2024, and the State General Election to be held on November 5, 2024, and that the County of Los Angeles take all necessary steps to hold consolidated elections.

Section 2. The City Clerk is instructed to cooperate with the Registrar-Recorder/County Clerk and to perform or cause to be performed such functions preliminary to the conduct of the Primary Nominating Election and General Municipal Election as may be agreed upon with the Registrar-Recorder/County Clerk.

Section 3. The City requests the Board of Supervisors to fix the costs to be paid for the consolidation of the Primary Nominating and General Municipal Elections. The City will reimburse the County for the City's share of the costs incurred in conducting the City's elections consistent with the cost estimate provided by the Registrar-Recorder/County Clerk and agreed to between the County and the City.

Section 4. The City requests the Board of Supervisors to issue instructions to the Registrar-Recorder/County Clerk to take any and all steps necessary on the part of the County to hold the Primary Nominating and General Municipal Elections.

Section 5. The City Attorney and the City Clerk are directed to take any and all steps necessary on the part of the City to hold the consolidated Primary Nominating and General Municipal Elections.

Section 6. The Registrar-Recorder/County Clerk is hereby authorized to canvass the returns of the Primary Nominating and General Municipal Elections requested herein to be consolidated.

Section 7. In all particulars not otherwise specifically provided in this Resolution and in the Ordinance calling the City's Primary Nominating and General Municipal Elections, the election shall be held and conducted as provided by law.

Section 8. The City Clerk is to file a duly certified copy of this Resolution forthwith with the Board of Supervisors with a copy also to be provided to the Registrar-Recorder/County Clerk.
