

RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, a Special Election was ordered to be held in the City of Los Angeles pursuant to Ordinance No. 188304 to place a measure before the voters and the election was consolidated with the City of Los Angeles General Municipal Election; and

WHEREAS, the following measure was submitted to a vote of the qualified voters of the City of Los Angeles:

CITY ETHICS COMMISSION AUTHORITY AND OPERATIONAL INDEPENDENCE. CHARTER AMENDMENT ER.

Shall the City Charter be amended to establish a minimum annual budget for the City Ethics Commission; increase the Commission's authority over spending decisions and hiring matters; allow the Commission to obtain outside counsel in limited circumstances; impose additional qualification requirements on Commission members; require the City Council to hold a public hearing on Commission proposals; and increase penalties for violations of City laws?

WHEREAS, the County of Los Angeles Registrar-Recorder/County Clerk did canvass the returns of the General Municipal Election held in the City of Los Angeles on November 5, 2024, and certified them to the City Clerk; and

WHEREAS, it appears to the Los Angeles City Council that the canvass of votes is true and correct.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Los Angeles City Council hereby finds, determines, and declares that the total number of votes cast for and against City of Los Angeles Charter Amendment ER at the General Municipal Election by the qualified voters was 1,159,538 as set forth in the certification of the Los Angeles City Clerk, and that the measure, as proposed by Resolution of the Los Angeles City Council, is hereby declared to have been approved by a majority of the voters voting thereon.
