

## RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, a Special Election was ordered to be held in the City of Los Angeles pursuant to Ordinance No. 188306 to place a measure before the voters and the election was consolidated with the City of Los Angeles General Municipal Election; and

WHEREAS, the following measure was submitted to a vote of the qualified voters of the City of Los Angeles:

### **LOS ANGELES FIRE AND POLICE PENSIONS; PEACE OFFICERS. CHARTER AMENDMENT FF.**

Shall the City Charter be amended to: allow peace officers employed by the Police, Airport, Harbor, and Recreation and Parks Departments to transfer membership and service from the Los Angeles City Employees' Retirement System to the Los Angeles Fire and Police Pension Plan; and require the City to pay associated costs, including refunds to certain Airport and Police Department members for prior transfers?

WHEREAS, the County of Los Angeles Registrar-Recorder/County Clerk did canvass the returns of the General Municipal Election held in the City of Los Angeles on November 5, 2024, and certified them to the City Clerk; and

WHEREAS, it appears to the Los Angeles City Council that the canvass of votes is true and correct.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Los Angeles City Council hereby finds, determines, and declares that the total number of votes cast for and against City of Los Angeles Charter Amendment FF at the General Municipal Election by the qualified voters was 1,176,009 as set forth in the certification of the Los Angeles City Clerk, and that the measure, as proposed by Resolution of the Los Angeles City Council, is hereby declared to have been approved by a majority of the voters voting thereon.
