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The Board of Police Commissioners serves as the head of the Los Angeles Police Department and is responsible for the oversight and issuance of police permits. Police permit applicants undergo a thorough review, which includes (but is not limited to) criminal history and conduct concerns of the applicant and business, a legal standing and zoning review, assurance of appropriate structural and occupant safety, fire plans, alcohol service (when applicable), and security concerns.

I THEREFORE MOVE that the Board of Police Commissioners BE REQUESTED to report back on an overview of all business types that require police permits for operation.

I FURTHER MOVE that the Board of Police Commissioners BE REQUESTED to report back with recommendations on the permits in which the regulatory benefit of a police permit has diminished and no longer seems necessary. This report should also include data to justify the removal of the police permit requirement that may be recommended by the Commission.
