

PUBLIC SAFETY and BUDGET AND FINANCE COMMITTEES' REPORT relative to the acceptance of the California Governor's Office of Emergency Services (CAL OES) Regional Urban Search and Rescue (US&R) Response Training Agreement.

Recommendation for Council action, SUBJECT TO THE APPROVAL OF THE MAYOR:

1. ACCEPT the Standard Agreement in the amount of \$169,950.00 for the performance period of January 1, 2024 through June 30, 2025, as granted by CalOES, and AUTHORIZE the Fire Chief, or designee, to execute any documents or agreements necessary to accept the agreement on the City's behalf.
2. AUTHORIZE the Fire Department to deposit the Standard Agreement funds received into Fund 335/38, Account to be determined.
3. AUTHORIZE the Fire Department to expend funds up to \$169,950.00 from LAFD General Fund 100/38, Account 6020 Operating Expense for consumables, travel expenses and student certification fees, in accordance with the CalOES US&R Training, for the performance period granted by CalOES; and AUTHORIZE the Fire Chief or designee, to execute any documents necessary to accept the award on the City's behalf.
4. AUTHORIZE the Controller, for reimbursement purposes, to transfer the Standard Agreement funds from Fund 335/38, Account to be determined, to Fund100/38 salary accounts: Account 001012 (Salaries Sworn), and Account 001098 (Variable Staffing), upon submission of proper documentation by the Fire Department of direct staff costs incurred during the agreement performance period.
5. AUTHORIZE the Fire Department to prepare Controller instructions for any technical adjustments, subject to approval of the City Administrative Officer (CAO), and AUTHORIZE the Controller to implement the instructions.

Fiscal Impact Statement: The CAO reports that approval of the recommendations in this report will allow for the acceptance of \$169,950.00 in Urban Search and Rescue staff training funding through an agreement with the California Governor's Office of Emergency Services (CalOES). Funding from the CalOES will be provided on a reimbursement basis with front-funding provided by the Fire Department. There is no fiscal impact to the General Fund.

Financial Policies Statement: The CAO reports that the recommendations provided in this report are in compliance with the City's Financial Policies, in that all agreement funding will be utilized for its intended purposes.

#### SUMMARY

At its regular meeting held on June 4, 2025, the Public Safety Committee considered Board of Fire Commissioners (BFC) and City Administrative Officer (CAO) reports relative to the acceptance of the California Governor's Office of Emergency Services (CAL OES) Regional Urban Search and Rescue (US&R) Response Training Agreement.

After an opportunity for public comment was held, the Committee moved to approve the recommendations contained within the City Administrative Officer report, as detailed above.

Subsequently, on June 17, 2025, the Budget and Finance Committee also considered this matter and after providing an opportunity for public comment, the Budget and Finance Committee concurred with the recommendations made previously by the Public Safety Committee.

This matter is now forwarded to the Council for its consideration.
