

MOTION

Over the past several months, HR&A Advisors, through funding from Southern California Grantmakers (CF-24-1179), has supported the City Administrative Officer (CAO) and the Los Angeles Housing Department (LAHD) to develop, track and analyze the city’s investments in homelessness services (CF-25-0576). Building on this work, HR&A Advisors will continue to support the City in its performance oversight work related to homelessness, regional coordination, and strategic analysis related to homelessness response over the course of Fiscal Year 2025-26 (FY25-26).


From January 1, 2026 through June 30, 2026, HR&A Advisors will provide intensive project management and analytic capacity to the City’s Homelessness Strategy Committee and the CAO of the City of Los Angeles. HR&A’s work will be organized under the following three tasks: 1) Support strong performance oversight and conduct operational problem solving to strengthen homelessness response, 2) Support strategic analysis, as directed by City Council and the Homeless Strategy Committee, and provide budgetary, programmatic, and policy research and analytic support for the City’s leadership on the Executive Committee for Regional Homeless Alignment and 3) Support the City with research and analysis to inform regional coordination on homelessness response.

To support the City with these critical efforts, HR&A Advisors will offer six months of intensive support as a uniquely qualified and trusted public policy consulting firm consisting of local government operations experts and homelessness response program and policy designers that work inside and outside of government to advance more just and equitable cities.

I THEREFORE MOVE that the Council instruct the City Administrative Officer (CAO)-to accept the in-kind consultancy services valued at the amount of \$1,100,000 million from California Community Foundation, the Conrad N. Hilton Foundation, and Southern California Grantmakers to Support strong performance oversight and conduct operational problem solving to strengthen homelessness response,


