### **Passage Routes**

The City of Los Angeles has made significant investments to increase the number of interim shelter beds for people experiencing homelessness (PEH) within Council District 11. There is an immediate need to provide safe spaces to unsheltered people living in the public rights-of-way in Council District 11. It is imperative that the areas within 500 ft of the passage routes within this resolution remain clear of encampments to ensure open, clear and safe public spaces for every person that may wish to pass safely through these communities.

\*Note: The data provided by LAFD is from 1/1/22 - 12/31/23 or, in the case of Rose Avenue, 1/1/23 - 4/30/24.

1) 705 Rose Avenue - Public Safety

a) For several years, numerous individuals have consistently maintained an encampment at 705 Rose Avenue, a vital thoroughfare providing coastal access for pedestrians who traverse its sidewalk. The sidewalk is often obstructed and poses a public safety issue for housed and unhoused residents alike. Over a 16 month period, the Fire Department reported 50 emergency incidents, including responding to encampment fires. For this public safety reason, sleeping or lodging within 500 feet of 705 Rose Avenue is unsafe, unhealthy, or incompatible with safe passage.

2) 2109 Pacific Avenue - Public Safety

a) For several years, numerous individuals have consistently maintained an encampment at 2109 Pacific Avenue, a vital thoroughfare providing coastal access for pedestrians who traverse its sidewalk. The sidewalk is often obstructed and poses a public safety issue for housed and unhoused residents alike. Over a 24 month period, the Fire Department reported more than 140 emergency incidents, including responding to 31 encampment fires. For this public safety reason, sleeping or lodging within 500 feet of 2109 Pacific Avenue is unsafe, unhealthy, or incompatible with safe passage.

3) 5424 Alvern Circle - Public Safety

a) For several years, numerous individuals have consistently maintained an encampment at 5424 Alvern Circle. The sidewalk is often obstructed and poses a public safety issue for housed and unhoused residents alike. Over a 24 month period, the Fire Department reported more than 28 emergency incidents, including responding to 4 encampment fires. For this public safety reason, sleeping or lodging within 500 feet of 5424 Alvern Circle is unsafe, unhealthy, or incompatible with safe passage.

4) Ohio and Bundy Triangle Park - Public Safety

- a) For several years, numerous individuals have consistently maintained an encampment at Ohio and Bundy Triangle Park. The sidewalk is often obstructed and poses a public safety issue for housed and unhoused residents alike. Over a 24 month period, the Fire Department reported more than 100 emergency incidents, including responding to 34 encampment fires. For this public safety reason, sleeping or lodging within 500 feet of Ohio and Bundy Triangle Park is unsafe, unhealthy, or incompatible with safe passage.
