

RULES, ELECTIONS AND INTERGOVERNMENTAL RELATIONS COMMITTEE REPORT and RESOLUTION relative to establishing the City's position on H.R. 3874 (Friedman)/S. 1870 (Schiff), the Rim of the Valley Corridor Preservation Act.

Recommendation for Council action, pursuant to Resolution (Raman – Rodriguez, et al.), SUBJECT TO THE CONCURRENCE OF THE MAYOR:

RESOLVE to include in the City's 2025-26 Federal Legislative Program SUPPORT for H.R. 3874 (Friedman)/S. 1870 (Schiff), the Rim of the Valley Corridor Preservation Act, which would adjust the boundary of the Santa Monica Mountains National Recreation Area to include the Rim of the Valley Corridor.

Fiscal Impact Statement: None submitted by the Chief Legislative Analyst. The City Administrative Officer has not completed a financial analysis of this report.

Community Impact Statement: None submitted.

Summary:

On February 6, 2026, your Rules, Elections and Intergovernmental Relations Committee considered a November 25, 2025 CLA report and a November 5, 2025 Resolution (Raman – Rodriguez, et al.), relative to establishing the City's position on H.R. 3874 (Friedman)/S. 1870 (Schiff), the Rim of the Valley Corridor Preservation Act. According to the Resolution, the bill would add more than 118,000 acres to the Santa Monica Mountains National Recreation Area and grant the National Park Service the authority to improve access, study wildlife, and coordinate conservation efforts. After consideration and having provided an opportunity for public comment, the Committee moved to recommend approval of the CLA report and Resolution. This matter is now submitted to Council for its consideration.
