RE: COUNCIL FILE TRANSMITTAL

On March 24, 2025, the Ad Hoc Committee for LA Recovery considered a City Administrative Officer (CAO) report, Community Investment for Families Department (CIFD) report and Motion (Hernandez, Price – Raman) relative to a guaranteed income program or emergency cash assistance program for Angelenos economically affected by the January 2025 wildfires., Council file No. 25-0002-S55. After consideration, the Committee moved to approve the following recommendations, as amended by Councilmembers Park and Soto-Martinez:

1. NOTE and FILE the CIFD report dated March 11, 2025 and the Motion (Hernandez, Price – Raman) dated January 21, 2025, both attached to Council file No. 25-0006-S44, inasmuch as no further Council action is required at this time.
2. INSTRUCT the CAO and the Chief Legislative Analyst to report to Council on the feasibility of using the Transfer of Floor Area Rights Public Benefit Trust Fund, Fire Aid grants, and funding sources other than the General Fund, to offset the costs of the CIFD proposed guaranteed basic income program or emergency cash assistance program for workers impacted by the January 2025 wildfires.
3. INSTRUCT the CIFD to report to Council on the feasibility of reprogramming up to \$1,000,000 of Program Year 50 2024-25 Community Development Block Grant funds for emergency assistance initiatives, including but not limited to rental assistance, in accordance with the United States Department of Housing and Urban Development guidelines, as a potential additional funding source to offset the costs of the CIFD proposed guaranteed basic income program or emergency cash assistance program for workers impacted by the January 2025 wildfires, as described in the CIFD report dated March 11, 2025, attached to the Council file.

This file is now transmitted to the Budget and Finance Committee.
