RE: COUNCIL FILE TRANSMITTAL

On November 17, 2025, the Ad Hoc Committee for LA Recovery considered a Motion (Park – Harris-Dawson relative to requesting the City Attorney to provide a report on the feasibility of implementing Mayor Karen Bass' October 9, 2025 request to Council relative to granting the Director of Finance of the Office of Finance increased delegated authority to promulgate rules that grant a one-time Measure ULA tax exemption to owners of all residential properties in the Pacific Palisades that were destroyed in the Palisades Fire; and related matters, Council file No. 25-0006-S86. After consideration, the Committee moved to approve the following recommendations:

1. REQUEST the City Attorney to provide an analysis of the proposal referenced in the Motion; and, if deemed feasible, REQUEST the City Attorney to prepare and present an ordinance to Council to effectuate the proposal, detailed in the October 9, 2025 letter issued by Mayor Karen Bass, within 30 days.
2. INSTRUCT the Office of Finance, in coordination with the City Attorney and the Chief Legislative Analyst, to present options for a ULA rebate program for eligible property owners if the City Attorney deems the suspension of Measure ULA for fire victims to be infeasible.
