

ITEM 2 AMENDMENT - Council File No. 25-0006-S35

- 1) Direct EMD, LAFD, and request the Mayor's Office of Public Safety to develop, adopt, and incorporate into the appropriate City Emergency Operations Plan (EOP) annex a formal Citywide protocol for PDS Red Flag Warnings, including automatic triggers for EOC activation, NotifyLA alerts, and departmental readiness actions.
- 2) Direct the Emergency Management Department (EMD) to submit a summary of all changes and updates to Council following the EOP annex or appendix approval by the Emergency Operations Board, in accordance with the City's EOP annex review cycle.
- 3) Instruct EMD, ITA, LAFD, and LADOT to integrate Red Flag alerts into City digital platforms (311, parking apps, navigation tools) and expand multilingual NotifyLA notifications.
- 4) Instruct LADOT, LAFD, LAPD, and request the City Attorney to report back on options to increase fines, allocate revenue to wildfire preparedness, and expand patrol and towing capacity during Red Flag and PDS events.
- 5) Instruct LADBS and LAFD, with the City Attorney, to recommend ordinance or code changes granting temporary authority to halt construction activities in Very High Fire Hazard Severity Zones during PDS Red Flag Days.
- 6) Request the City Attorney, with RAP and LAFD, to amend LAMC §63.44(P) to expand open-flame restrictions to include fire danger rating criteria in addition to calendar dates.
- 7) Instruct the City Attorney, with consultation from LAFD and LAPD, to draft enforceable restrictions on outdoor barbecuing, fire pits, and open-flame activities in residential areas during Red Flag Warnings.
- 8) Instruct LAPD to report on the proposed amendment to its contract with the Official Police Garage in regards to the "unusual occurrence" clause. This clause should allow the mobilization of tow units Citywide (in a mutual aid style configuration, regardless of service area sovereignty, to include mobilization of regular, medium, and heavy-duty tows) during Red Flag and PDS events.
- 9) Instruct/request LAPD, LAHSA, LAFD, EMD, and RAP to prepare standardized evacuation and notification protocols for unhoused residents during wildfire or Red Flag emergencies.
- 10) Instruct RAP, EMD and LAFD to create policy and procedures for park closure determinations during PDS events. The policy and procedures should include internal and external communication protocols as well as enforcement measures in the event of a park closure due to PDS.

11) Instruct the CAO to report back on the establishment of a Red Flag Specific Overtime and Augmentation Fund to support staffing and resource needs during declared Red Flag or PDS Red Flag events.
