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Comments for Public Posting: Another symbolic motion: What about addressing consistent, blatant lack of enforcement. What is the point of passing yet another redundant motion and posting more signs when existing signs, designed to address this very issue, are simply ignored by both violators, the city, LAPD, and the Department of Transportation? In District 6, the result is obvious: we have become a dumping ground for oversized, abandoned, vandalized, stolen, and dismantled vehicles, vehicular dwellings. The signs are meaningless without real, visible enforcement, and it is a waste of time and public resources to approve rules that are never acted upon. Most of the affected streets already have no overnight parking restrictions, so instead of posting “overnight parking prohibited” signs, the city should post “No Stopping Any Time” signs to clearly communicate the restriction. But again, without enforcement, who will uphold these rules? Other, more prominent parts of Los Angeles do not face this level of dereliction from enforcement agencies. Enforcement must be a core part of this conversation. The signs should clearly state “NO STOPPING ANY TIME, TOW AWAY,” and, critically, immediate towing must occur when violations are observed. DOT’s, the city’s, LAPD’s and LASAN’s ongoing neglect only penalizes long-standing, law-abiding residents of District 6.
