

TRANSPORTATION COMMITTEE REPORT relative to establishing oversized vehicle parking restrictions along a street segment of Shoup Avenue, in Council District Three (CD 3).

SUBMITS WITHOUT RECOMMENDATION the Recommendation pursuant to Resolution (Blumenfield – Lee):

RESOLVE to:

1. PROHIBIT, pursuant to Los Angeles Municipal Code (LAMC) Section 80.69.4, the parking of vehicles that are in excess of 22 feet in length or over seven (7) feet in height, during the hours of 2:00 a.m. and 6:00 a.m., along the east side of Shoup Avenue, between Roscoe Boulevard and Strathern Street.
2. DIRECT the Los Angeles Department of Transportation (LADOT), upon adoption of this Resolution, to:
 - a. Post signs giving notice of a “tow away, no parking” restriction for oversized vehicles, with the specific hours detailed, at the above locations.
 - b. Initiate the necessary procedures for the preparation and sale of overnight parking permits, as specified in LAMC Section 80.69.4(c).
3. AUTHORIZE the LADOT to make technical corrections or clarifications to the above instructions in order to effectuate the intent of this Resolution.

Fiscal Impact Statement: Neither the City Administrative Officer nor the Chief Legislative Analyst has completed a financial analysis of this report.

Community Impact Statement: None submitted.

Summary:

On October 22, 2025, your Transportation Committee considered an September 16, 2025 Resolution (Blumenfield – Lee) relative to establishing oversized vehicle parking restrictions along a street segment of Shoup Avenue, in CD 3, as detailed in the Resolution and in Recommendation No. 1 above. Pursuant to LAMC Section 80.69.4, it is proposed that the parking of vehicles that are in excess of 22 feet in length or over 7 feet in height, during the hours of 2:00 a.m. and 6:00 a.m., be prohibited along the street segment as detailed in Recommendation No. 1. After consideration and having provided an opportunity for public comment, the Committee submits without recommendation the Resolution recommendations. This matter is now submitted to the Council for consideration.
