

TRANSPORTATION COMMITTEE REPORT relative to establishing oversize vehicle parking restrictions along certain street segments of Sunland Boulevard, Gladstone Avenue, and Borden Avenue, in Council District Seven (CD 7).

Recommendation for Council action, pursuant to Resolution (Rodriguez – Lee):

RESOLVE to:

1. PROHIBIT, pursuant to Los Angeles Municipal Code (LAMC) Section 80.69.4, the parking of vehicles that are in excess of 22 feet in length or over seven (7) feet in height, during the hours of 2:00 a.m. and 6:00 a.m., along both sides of the following street segments:
 - a. Sunland Boulevard between Stonehurst Avenue and Sunland Park Drive
 - b. Gladstone Avenue between Sayre Street and Hubbard Street
 - c. Borden Avenue between Arroyo Avenue and Corcoran Street
2. DIRECT the Department of Transportation (DOT), upon adoption of this Resolution, to post signs giving notice of a “tow away, no parking” restriction for oversize vehicles, with the specific hours detailed, at the above locations.
3. AUTHORIZE the DOT to make technical corrections or clarifications to the above instructions in order to effectuate the intent of this Resolution.

Fiscal Impact Statement: Neither the City Administrative Officer nor the Chief Legislative Analyst has completed a financial analysis of this report.

Community Impact Statement: None submitted.

Summary:

On January 28, 2026, your Transportation Committee considered a December 2, 2025 Resolution (Rodriguez – Lee) relative to establishing oversize vehicle parking restrictions along certain street segments of Sunland Boulevard, Gladstone Avenue, and Borden Avenue, in CD 7. as detailed in the Resolution and in Recommendation No. 1 above. Pursuant to LAMC Section 80.69.4, it is proposed that the parking of vehicles that are in excess of 22 feet in length or over 7 feet in height, during the hours of 2:00 a.m. and 6:00 a.m., be prohibited along the street segment as detailed in Recommendation No. 1. After consideration and having provided an opportunity for public comment, the Committee recommended approval of the Resolution recommendations. This matter is now submitted to the Council for consideration.
