MOTION

Council District 12 seeks to continue its partnership with Los Angeles Conservation Corps (LACC) for services such as median maintenance and beautification, weed & graffiti abatement, alley and street cleanup, and bulky item pickup. This partnership is and will continue to improve neighborhoods throughout Council District 12.

I THEREFORE MOVE that \$250,000 of the Council District 12 portion of the Street Furniture Revenue Fund No. 43D, Department 50 be transferred / appropriated to the Board of Public Works Fund No. 100-74 Account No. 3040 (Contractual Services) for various street and neighborhood cleanup and maintenance services throughout Council District 12 coordinated by the Los Angeles Conservation Corps.

I FURTHER MOVE that \$150,000 in the Sunshine Canyon Communities Amenities Trust Fund No. 699-14 be transferred / appropriated to the Board of Public Works Fund No. 100-74 Account No. 3040 (Contractual Services) for various street and neighborhood cleanup and maintenance services throughout Council District 12 coordinated by the Los Angeles Conservation Corps.

I FURTHER MOVE that the Board of Public Works, Office of Community Beautification, be authorized to prepare the necessary documents with an/or payments to the Los Angeles Conservation Corps, or any other agency or organization, in the above amount for the above purpose, subject to the approval of the City Attorney as to form.

I FURTHER MOVE that the Department of Public Works, Office of Accounting be authorized to make any technical corrections or clarification as necessary to the above instructions in order to effectuate the intent of the motion.
