

MOTION

I MOVE that the matter of the Civil Rights, Equity, Immigration, Aging and Disability Committee Report relative to department efforts to provide information regarding immigration-related rights to residents of Los Angeles, Item 6 on today's Council Agenda (Council File 25-0106), BE AMENDED to


- ADD the following recommendations:

INSTRUCT the Los Angeles Police Department (LAPD) to report on the department's process for handling U-Visa requests, which are available to undocumented immigrants when subject to certain crimes, such as domestic violence, sexual assault, and other crimes. The report should provide:

- a. An overview of LAPD's procedures for certifying U-Visas for victims of qualifying crimes;
- b. Data on the number of U-Visa certification requests received and granted by LAPD since 2017; and
- c. Any challenges or barriers victims may face when seeking U-Visa certification.

INSTRUCT LAPD to report on the Department's Immigration Policy and how the department publicizes and educates the public about their policies.
