Honorable Members:

This Office recommends that discussion with, and advice from, legal counsel for City Council action be scheduled and held in closed session pursuant to California Government Code Section 54956.9(d)(2) and (e)(2) (one potential case). Government Code Section 54956.9(e)(2) requires you to state publicly prior to the closed session what subdivision of this section authorizes the closed meeting, and that the closed session is being held to confer or discuss with, or receive advice from, legal counsel regarding a significant exposure to litigation regarding facts and circumstances that are known to a potential plaintiff or plaintiffs, that might result in litigation against the City, and which facts or circumstances shall be publicly stated on the agenda or announced. The significant exposure to litigation involves potential claims relating the 2021 City Council redistricting plan and its compliance under the Fair Maps Act and open meeting and records laws relating to the City's 2021 redistricting process.
