

HOUSING AND HOMELESSNESS COMMITTEE REPORT relative to a contract with Hope the Mission to implement the Encampment Resolution Fund Grant for the San Fernando Osborne Program which provides services for people experiencing homelessness in the community of Pacoima.

Recommendations for Council action, pursuant to Motion (Rodriguez - Hernandez), SUBJECT TO THE APPROVAL OF THE MAYOR:

1. AUTHORIZE the City Administrative Officer (CAO), or designee, to execute a contract with Hope the Mission to implement the Encampment Resolution Fund Grant for the San Fernando Osborne program in Council District 7 in an amount not to exceed \$2,341,821.97, not to exceed a total of 36 months, subject to the availability of funds, compliance with City contracting requirements, and approval by the City Attorney as to form.
2. INSTRUCT and AUTHORIZE the CAO to prepare, process and execute the necessary documents with and/or payments to Hope the Mission, or any other agency or organization, as appropriate, utilizing the above amount, for the above purpose, subject to the approval of the City Attorney as to form.

Fiscal Impact Statement: Neither the CAO nor the Chief Legislative Analyst has completed a financial analysis of this report.

SUMMARY
