

MOTION

I HEREBY MOVE that the Council ADOPT the following recommendations in order to effect settlement in the case entitled Kimberly Marroquin v. Unidentified Los Angeles Police Department Officer, et al., United States District Court Case No. 21-cv-07607-RGK-JEM, Ninth Circuit Court of Appeal Case No. 23-55423. (This matter arises from an incident involving members of the Los Angeles Police Department that occurred on October 11, 2020.), **SUBJECT TO THE APPROVAL OF THE MAYOR:**

1. AUTHORIZE the City Attorney's Office to expend up to **\$1,163,553** in settlement of the above-entitled matter.
2. AUTHORIZE the Controller to transfer **\$1,163,553** plus accrued interest, from the Liability Claims Fund No. 100/59, Account No. 009798, Miscellaneous Liability Payouts, to Fund No. 100/59, Account No. 009792, Police Liability Payouts.
3. AUTHORIZE the City Attorney to draw a demand from Fund No. 100/59, Account No. 009792, Police Liability Payouts, as follows:
 - a. Conlogue Law, LLP and Kimberly Marroquin in the amount of **\$1,041,587.60**, plus accrued interest at the rate of 4.8% until paid.
 - b. Law Offices of Steven B. Stevens, APC in the amount of **\$111,090.40**.
 - c. Conlogue Law, LLP, in the amount of \$10,875.
4. AUTHORIZE the City Attorney, or designee, to make necessary technical adjustments, subject to the approval of the City Administrative Officer; and, AUTHORIZE the Controller to implement the instructions.

This matter was recommended for approval by the Budget and Finance Committee (Yaroslavsky – Blumenfield – Hutt – McOsler – Hernandez: "Yes") at its meeting held on March 18, 2025, in Closed Session as permitted by Government Code Section 54956.9(d)(1).
