ENERGY AND ENVIRONMENT COMMITTEE REPORT relative to the status of the Fats, Oil and Grease Program.

Recommendation for Council action, pursuant to Motion (Rodriguez – Blumenfield):

INSTRUCT the Bureau of Sanitation (BOS) to report in 45 days on the status of the Fats, Oil and Grease Program, and the feasibility of adjusting the \$100,000 monetary threshold related to the remodeling of FSEs to install grease interceptors, and other renovations which mitigates the inappropriate disposal of waste products into the sewer system from these locations. The report should include ways the BOS can enhance its media and educational outreach programs across all social media and communication platforms to re-engage the public and industry that their compliance and diligence keeps the waste disposal infrastructure in top shape to protect the entire community from overflows and hazards.

<u>Fiscal Impact Statement</u>: Neither the City Administrative Officer nor the Chief Legislative Analyst has completed a financial analysis of this report.
