

HOUSING AND HOMELESSNESS COMMITTEE REPORT relative to policies the City has adopted that can enable successful implementation of Los Angeles County Affordable Housing Solutions Agency (LACAHSAs) funded programs that meet current and emerging challenges in the housing sector.

Recommendation for Council action, pursuant to Motion (Raman - Harris-Dawson):

INSTRUCT the Los Angeles Housing Department, in coordination with the Chief Legislative Analyst (CLA) and the Department of City Planning to report within 30 days on policies that the City has adopted that can enable us to successfully implement programs funded by LACAHSAs, including programs developed for United to House LA, policy recommendations that the City can adopt that would ensure greater access to LACAHSAs funds, and how the City can best support the development of strong program guidelines at LACAHSAs prior to the June 2025 deadline that meet current and emerging challenges in the housing sector.

Fiscal Impact Statement: Neither the City Administrative Officer nor the CLA has completed a financial analysis of this report.
