Pursuant to your request, this Office has prepared and now transmits for your consideration the enclosed draft ordinance, approved as to form and legality. The draft ordinance amends Section 22.322 of Article 3, Chapter 13, Division 22 of the Los Angeles Administrative Code to assign the responsibility for maintaining City bicycle and multi-use paths, other than those under the control, operation, or management of the Board of Recreation and Parks Commissioners or the Proprietary Departments, to the Department of Public Works.
