

TRANSPORTATION COMMITTEE REPORT relative to a pilot program on utilizing cameras and related technologies for the enforcement of parking violations in bicycle lanes, along Hollywood Boulevard, in Council District (CD) 13.

Recommendation for Council action, pursuant to Motion (Soto-Martinez – Hutt, Blumenfield):

INSTRUCT the Los Angeles Department of Transportation (LADOT) to report on the feasibility of implementing a pilot project that would utilize cameras and related technologies for the enforcement of parking violations in bicycle lanes, along Hollywood Boulevard in Council District 13, in accordance with California Vehicle Code Section 40245 including:

- An assessment of available parking enforcement technologies for enforcing bicycle lane parking violations.
- The feasibility of contracting with vendors that provide parking enforcement services.
- Recommendations for providing alternative payment options to under-resourced individuals facing parking citations as a result of automated enforcement programs.
- The staff and budget necessary to implement the proposed pilot.
- How revenue from a permanent program could be directed specifically to the LADOT to be earmarked for Active Transportation efforts.

Fiscal Impact Statement: Neither the City Administrative Officer nor the Chief Legislative Analyst has completed a financial analysis of this report.

Community Impact Statement: Yes.

Summary:

On June 11, 2025, your Transportation Committee considered a May 20, 2025 Motion (Soto-Martinez – Hutt, Blumenfield) relative to a pilot program on utilizing cameras and related technologies for the enforcement of parking violations in bicycle lanes, along Hollywood Boulevard, in CD 13. According to the Motion, the right-of-way for bicycle lanes must be protected to ensure safe use. Across the city, vehicles are observed parking or idling in bicycle lanes, forcing people bicycling into dangerous situations. After consideration and having provided an opportunity for public comment, the Committee moved to recommend approval of the Motion recommendation. This matter is now submitted to Council for its consideration.
