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Comments for Public Posting: It has been 26 years since the adoption of Sun Valley-La Tuna Canyon Community Plan of 1999; over two decades and this plan is still on paper only. Elelcteds come and go with loud promises but no action whatsoever. Life is changing, our community continues being used as a dumping ground of recycling plants, unchecked auto businesses, unchecked cannabis businesses, unchecked scrap yards, as well as multitude of tiny homes, low income houses, special service houses, whatever houses - in other words, all types of houses except normal housing for average Sun Valley resident who works really hard, sometimes more than one job, pays taxes, obides by the rules, yet, gets no service in return, thanks to corrupt council district six office and more corrupt los angeles police department and every other city department in the labyrinth of departments mostly run by inept, incompetent, lazy, and unresourceful folks detached from relaities on ground zero.
