Pursuant to your request in Exhibit H of the FY 25-26 Adopted City Budget, this Office has prepared and now transmits for your consideration the enclosed draft ordinance, approved as to form and legality. The draft ordinance amends Subsection (d) of Section 5.344 of Chapter 31, Division 5 of the Los Angeles Administrative Code to allow the City Employees Ridesharing Trust Fund to reimburse for the costs of positions supporting the City ridesharing and parking program.
