TRANSPORTATION COMMITTEE REPORT relative to establishing a parking meter zone on Adams Boulevard, between La Brea Avenue and Hauser Boulevard.

Recommendation for Council action, pursuant to Motion (Hutt – Lee):

DIRECT the Los Angeles Department of Transportation to report within 30 days on the feasibility and necessary steps to establish a parking meter zone on Adams Boulevard, between La Brea Avenue and Hauser Boulevard, including cost, revenue impact, and timeline.

<u>Fiscal Impact Statement</u>: Neither the City Administrative Officer nor the Chief Legislative Analyst has completed a financial analysis of this report.

Community Impact Statement: None submitted.

Summary:

On June 11, 2025, your Transportation Committee considered a June 11, 2025 Motion (Hutt – Lee) relative to establishing a parking meter zone on Adams Boulevard, between La Brea Avenue and Hauser Boulevard. According to the Motion, Adams Boulevard, between La Brea Avenue and Hauser Boulevard, is a busy commercial corridor with a mix of small businesses, churches, and residential buildings, and with little on-street parking to accommodate the needs of the community. The installation of parking meters along this roadway segment could provide an effective mechanism to provide more parking access to patrons and visitors, while creating sufficient turnover for businesses. After consideration and having provided an opportunity for public comment, the Committee moved to recommend approval of the Motion recommendation. This matter is now submitted to Council for its consideration.
