

MOTION

As a result of a water service line leak on January 9, 2024, near 1816 Sunset Plaza Drive within the area of Council District 4, the slope adjacent to the street experienced erosion. The repair of the slope is critical to the integrity of the roadway in this hillside area.


The Los Angeles Department of Public Works-Bureau of Engineering (BOE) is providing assistance to Los Angeles Department of Water and Power (LADWP) to repair the street and stabilize the slope. BOE will provide project management, design, construction management, and related services to oversee and perform the repairs. BOE will utilize their prequalified on-call construction contracts to perform the repair.

Action is needed to approve a transfer of funds totaling \$1,087,000 from LADWP to BOE to reimburse City staff for project management, design, construction management, and construction costs associated with the repair. BOE will solicit competitive bids from its prequalified on-call construction contractors list to perform the repair.

I THEREFORE MOVE that Council District 4 approve the contribution/payment/transfer of \$1,087,000 from LADWP Fund No. 705, Department No. 98, Blanket Authority No. 3172-5 into a new appropriation unit within the Engineering Special Services Fund, Fund No. 682, Department No. 50 (682/50) entitled *Sunset Plaza Drive (1816) Bulkhead - LADWP*, for services associated with damage assessment, engineering design, project management, and construction costs to repair the damage to the slope along Sunset Plaza Drive and repair the roadway. Any remaining funds in the Sunset Plaza Drive (1816) Bulkhead – LADWP account shall be returned to LADWP.

I FURTHER MOVE that BOE be authorized to make any corrections, clarifications, or revisions to the above fund transfer instructions, including any new instructions in order to effectuate the intent of this Motion, and any corrections and changes to fund or account numbers; said corrections/clarification/changes may be made orally, electronically, or by any other means.
