RE: ECONOMIC AND WORKFORCE DEVELOPMENT REPORT-BACK ON VACANCIES AND OPPORTUNITIES FOR TRANSFERS

SUMMARY

As directed by Council File (CF) 25-0660, this report provides a response to the number of vacancies, number of transfers (or opportunities for transfers), and classifications of transfers to or from the Economic and Workforce Development Department (EWDD). As of August 8, 2025, EWDD's current number of vacancies by classification is 25.

RECOMMENDATION

That the City Council note and file this report.

BACKGROUND

The Personnel and Hiring Committee instructed departments to provide a written report on the current number of vacancies, the number of transfers (or opportunities for transfers), and the classifications of transfers to or from the department.

DISCUSSION

EWDD is providing the following summary of its 25 vacancies by classification as of August 8, 2025. Efforts are currently underway to fill the Department's vacancies by utilizing the Expedited Transfer Process (ETP). The Department's vacancies include nine (9) exempt positions (i.e., Project Coordinators (3), Senior Project Assistants (3), and Senior Project Coordinators (3)) that can be posted on the Personnel's job central and must also go through the ETP. To date, EWDD has identified nine (9) common classifications, out of 12, that can be filled through the ETP.

Since June 1, 2025, zero employees have transferred into EWDD, while five (5) have transferred out or retired.

The Fiscal Year 2025-26 Adopted Budget deleted seven (7) positions at EWDD, of which three positions were filled. EWDD reassigned the affected staff to available vacant positions to avoid layoffs, either as lateral, in-lieu, or out-of-class internal transfers.
