

ARTS, PARKS, LIBRARIES, AND COMMUNITY ENRICHMENT COMMITTEE REPORT relative to executing an agreement between the Department of Recreation and Parks and the Trust for Public Land, for the development, construction, and renovation of a portion of Ritchie Valens Recreation Center, located at 10736 Laurel Canyon Boulevard.

Recommendation for Council action:

AUTHORIZE the Board of Recreation and Parks Commissioners (Board), or designee, to execute the proposed agreement between the Department of Recreation and Parks and the Trust for Public Land (TPL), for the development, construction, and renovation of a portion of Ritchie Valens Recreation Center, located at 10736 Laurel Canyon Boulevard, Pacoima, CA 91331, for a term of twenty years upon execution, subject to review and approval of the City Attorney as to form.

Fiscal Impact Statement: The City Administrative Officer (CAO) reports that The Trust for Public Land (TPL) received grant funding in the amount of \$1,000,000.00 from the State of California Natural Resources Agency (CNRA) for the installation of urban greening, pedestrian improvements, and storm water capture features in Paxton Park. The completed improvements will require ongoing maintenance by the Department for a minimum of twenty years. The maintenance needs for the improvements is subject to future appropriation by Mayor and Council through the annual budget process. The anticipated maintenance costs cannot be determined at this time.

Financial Policies Statement: The CAO reports that to the extent applicable, the recommendation above complies with the City Financial Policies in that ongoing revenue will be used to meet ongoing expenditures.
