

# MOTION

The Sunshine Canyon Community Amenities Trust Fund provides funds for financing community amenities within the City of Los Angeles, within five miles of the Sunshine Canyon landfill.

Streetlights are a critical component of urban infrastructure, providing safety and security for residents and businesses. In Council District 12, many neighborhoods have been left without street lighting due to prolonged outages caused by copper wire theft and vandalism. Studies show that adequate street lighting can improve security and deter crime.

There is a need for solar street light conversions within Council District 12. Solar street lights are available and will provide the necessary improvements for the overall quality of life for residents in CD12. This effort is of special benefit for the residents of the City and for CD12 and deserves financial assistance from the City. Sufficient funds are available in Sunshine Canyon Community Amenities Trust Fund which could be used for this purpose.

**I THEREFORE MOVE** that the Council RESOLVE that \$300,000 in the Sunshine Canyon Community Amenities Trust Fund No. 699-14 be transferred / appropriated to the below listed accounts in the amounts specified in the Street Lighting Fund No. 100-84, for the purchase and installation of solar-powered lights within five miles of the Sunshine Canyon landfill in Council District 12:
