Recommendation for Council action, pursuant to Motion (Raman - Yaroslavsky):

INSTRUCT the Los Angeles Housing Department; and, REQUEST the Housing Authority of the City of Los Angeles, with the assistance of the Chief Legislative Analyst (CLA), to identify funding sources to provide on-going operating subsidy to continue PSH development in the City and best ways to leverage City's funds and advocate for the availability of those dollars for this purpose. These sources should include but are not limited to the following:

- a. The State's Multifamily Housing Program
- b. Behavioral Health Services Act's Housing Intervention funds
- c. Measure A funds
- d. Philanthropic funding
