

MOTION

As part of the City's response to the homelessness crisis, the City is working to clear encampments that obstruct public rights-of-way, including those involving recreational vehicles. To continue these efforts effectively, the City requires additional space to store relinquished vehicles. The Mayor's Office has identified a suitable 94,500 square-foot lot at 6338 Balboa Boulevard in Council District six that would meet this need. Currently, this lot is owned by the Los Angeles County Metropolitan Transportation Authority (Metro) therefore, in order to utilize the space, the City must first enter into a lease agreement with Metro.

I THEREFORE MOVE that City Council instruct the General Services Department, with the assistance of the City Attorney and the City Administrative Officer, in consultation with the Council Office, to negotiate and execute a lease agreement with the Los Angeles County Metropolitan Transportation Authority for the lot located at 6338 Balboa Boulevard.
