**SUBJECT:** TRANSMITTAL OF THE APPLICATION AND GRANT AWARD FOR THE 2024 PAUL COVERDELL FORENSIC SCIENCES IMPROVEMENT GRANT FROM THE CALIFORNIA GOVERNOR'S OFFICE OF EMERGENCY SERVICES

**RECOMMENDED ACTIONS**

1. That the Board of Police Commissioners (Board) REVIEW and APPROVE this report.
2. That the Board TRANSMIT the attached application and grant award, pursuant to Administrative Code Section 14.6(a), to the Mayor, Office of the City Administrative Officer (CAO), Office of the Chief Legislative Analyst and to the City Clerk for Committee and City Council consideration; and
3. That the Board REQUEST the Mayor and City Council to:
  - A. AUTHORIZE the Chief of Police or his designee to retroactively APPLY for and ACCEPT the grant award of \$148,457 for the 2024 Paul Coverdell Forensic Sciences Improvement Program (Coverdell Program) from the California Governor's Office of Emergency Services (Cal OES), for the period of April 1, 2025 through March 31, 2026;
  - B. AUTHORIZE the Chief of Police or his designee to negotiate and execute the grant award agreement, subject to the review of the City Attorney as to form and legality;
  - C. AUTHORIZE the Controller to set up a grant receivable and appropriate \$148,457 to an appropriation account number to be determined in Fund No. 339, Department No. 70, for the receipt and disbursements of the Cal OES 2024 Coverdell Program grant funds;
  - D. AUTHORIZE the Los Angeles Police Department (LAPD) to spend up to the grant amount of \$148,457 in accordance with the grant award agreement;
  - E. AUTHORIZE the LAPD to submit grant reimbursement requests to the grantor and deposit grant receipts into Fund No. 339, Department No. 70;
  - F. AUTHORIZE the Controller to increase appropriations on an as needed basis for the Cal OES 2024 Paul Coverdell Program as follows:

G. AUTHORIZE the LAPD to prepare the Controller's instructions for any technical adjustments, subject to the approval of the CAO, and AUTHORIZE and INSTRUCT the Controller to implement the instructions.

## DISCUSSION

The California Governor's Office of Emergency Services has awarded \$148,457 in 2024 Coverdell Program grant funding to the LAPD. Of this amount, \$141,185 will support civilian overtime, with \$7,272 allocated for related fringe benefits. The funding will enhance the quality, timeliness, and efficiency of forensic science services by supporting extended work hours for analysts in the Forensic Science Division (FSD) and Technical Investigation Division (TID), specifically for field response, firearm analysis, and latent print analysis.

## Narrative Questions/Responses

### Question 1 \*

*Describe the plan to implement a program intended to improve the quality and timeliness of forensic science or medical examiner/coroner's office services in the state.*

*The Los Angeles Police Department (LAPD), through the 2024-25 Paul Coverdell Forensic Science Improvement (CQ) Program, will provide increase work hours in both the Forensic Science Division (FSD) and Technical Investigation Division (TID). The grant program will improve the quality and timeliness of forensic science services through extended work hours and ensuring workload is completed and reduce and/or prevent backlog. There are three main activities that are proposed under the 2024-25 CQ:*

*a. Increase Firearm Analysis Capacity: FSD - Firearm Analysis Unit (FAU). An estimated 691 hours will be made available to the FAU staff to complete firearm-related analyses and the necessary review activities (including complex microscopic comparisons and timely NIBIN operations), bullet path analysis and crime scene processing, and internal training activities.*

*b. Increase Field Response Capacity: FSD - Field Investigation Unit (FIU). An estimated 77 hours will be made available to FIU staff to perform crime scene processing activities that include responding to scenes off-duty, packaging and booking evidence, and case reviews.*

*c. Increase Latent Analysis Capacity: TID - Latent Print Unit (LPU). An estimated 470 hours will be made available to LPU staff to complete analysis of latent print evidence and case reviews.*

### Question 2 \*

*Indicate how backlogs will be eliminated in the analysis of forensic science evidence, including, but not limited to, a backlog with respect to firearms examination, latent prints, impression evidence, toxicology, digital evidence, fire evidence, controlled substances, forensic pathology, questioned documents, and trace evidence.*

*The City of Los Angeles instituted a hiring freeze in January 2024 and both FSD and TID struggle to maintain timely forensic services with multiple vacancies unfilled. Staff in FSD and TID regularly work overtime to conduct forensic analyses; however, City funds are limited and staff are compensated with 1.5 hours of time-off for each hour of overtime worked. The grant funds for overtime are essential to maintain unit operations to ensure staff continues to complete casework and/or respond to crime scenes, instead of taking time off.*

*Currently, the TID LPU carries a 200-case backlog while the FSD FAU is managing 131 open requests, with 16 requests over 90 days and considered "backlogged". The funding will be used to reduce the current backlogs by analyzing latent print evidence, performing firearms-related analyses, completing technical and administrative reviews for these forensic analyses, and training additional staff to perform these tasks.*

*Describe the plan to employ, train, and assist, forensic laboratory personnel and medicolegal death investigators, as needed, to eliminate backlogs.*

*The LAPD will utilize program funds to increase work hours in both the FSD-FAU, FSD-FIU, and TID-LPU. The grant program will increase these units' efficiency while reducing and eliminating backlogs by performing forensic analyses and related technical and administrative reviews, responding to and processing crime scenes, as well completing internal training activities in FAU.*
