

MOTION

I HEREBY MOVE that the Council ADOPT the following recommendations in order to effect settlement in the case entitled Ligia Ramirez, et al. v. City of Los Angeles, et al., Los Angeles Superior Court Case No. 21STCV08069. (This matter arises from a vehicle versus vehicle car accident on May 7, 2020, at Wilmington and East 108th Street.), **SUBJECT TO THE APPROVAL OF THE MAYOR:**

1. AUTHORIZE the City Attorney's Office to expend up to **\$895,000** in settlement of the above-entitled matter.
2. AUTHORIZE the Controller to transfer **\$895,000** from the Liability Claims Fund No. 100/59, Account No. 009798, Miscellaneous Liability Payouts, to Fund No. 100/59, Account No. 009792, Police Liability Payouts.
3. AUTHORIZE the City Attorney to draw a demand(s) from Fund No. 100/59, Account No. 009792, Police Liability Payouts, payable to: Mark H. Aprahamian, P.C. Client Trust Account in the amount of **\$895,000**, breakdown as follows:
 - a. **\$5,000** to Mark H. Aprahamian, P.C. and Sebastian Obregon, a minor by and through his GAL mother Cristina Ramirez.
 - b. **\$140,000** to Mark H. Aprahamian, P.C. and Ligia Ramirez.
 - c. **\$750,000** to Mark H. Aprahamian, P.C. and Cristina Ramirez.
4. AUTHORIZE the City Attorney, or designee, to make necessary technical adjustments, subject to the approval of the City Administrative Officer; and, AUTHORIZE the Controller to implement the instructions.
