APPROVE the Right of Entry agreement attached to the Department of Animal Services report, dated June 20, 2025, attached to the Council file, with San Diego Humane Society to park one mobile spay/neuter clinic vehicle for the purpose of providing the donated spay and neuter services at the City's six Animal Services Centers.
