## Recommendations for Council action:

  to the Animal Services report dated June 20, 2025, attached to the Council file, to
  provide the donated animal intervention services at the Chesterfield Square Animal
  Services Center.
- AUTHORIZE the Department's General Manager to execute the ROE upon receipt of all necessary approvals.
