PUBLIC WORKS COMMITTEE REPORT relative to issuing a Revocable Permit for the construction of permanent improvements within the public right-of-way at Moss Avenue from Fletcher Drive to its southeasterly terminus joining Roswell Street to the intersection of Estara Avenue prior to the adoption of the Street Vacation.

Recommendation for Council action, pursuant to Motion (Soto-Martínez – Yaroslavsky):

AUTHORIZE the Bureau of Engineering to issue a Revocable Permit to allow the Los Angeles Unified School District, subject to satisfaction of conditions for issuing such permit, to close, gate, occupy, demolish, excavate and commence construction of permanent improvements within the existing public right-of-way at Moss Avenue from Fletcher Drive to its southeasterly terminus joining Roswell Street to the intersection of Estara Avenue prior to the adoption of the Street Vacation (VAC-E1401463).
