Over the past two years, Council District 4 has convened a Working Group focused on the Hollywood Sign area and Western Griffith Park. This group contains representatives from local residential associations, Neighborhood Councils, and Griffith Park advocacy groups and helps advise on issues and projects related to the area.

As a result of these meetings as well as community conversations with local residents and stakeholders, a re-prioritization of implementation projects has occurred, resulting in the need to close out one project to fund two other needed projects. The first would concretize existing deep and persistent ruts in the parkway of Canyon Lake Drive which pose a tripping hazard in a location with hundreds of people parking and walking across the ruts on a daily basis. The second project is a permanent fence along Mulholland Highway under the Hollywood Sign in order to occlude the view from the roadway and deter people stopping vehicles in the street to take pictures, a persistent problem before the installation of a temporary fence that has exceeded its lifespan and needs to be replaced with a permanent fence.

I THEREFORE MOVE that \$100,000 be transferred / appropriated from the Capital Improvement Expenditure Program Fund No. 100-54, Account No. 00ABAJ (Wonder View Trails Extension) as follows: \$72,000 to Bureau of Street Services Fund No. 100-86, Account No. 001090 (Salaries, Overtime), \$15,000 to Bureau of Street Services Fund No. 100-86, Account No. 003030 (Construction Expense), \$8,000 to Bureau of Street Services Fund No. 100-86, Account No. 003040 (Contractual Services), and \$5,000 to Bureau of Street Services Fund No. 100-86, Account No. 006020 (Operating Supplies).

I FURTHER MOVE that \$350,000 be transferred / appropriated from the Capital Improvement Expenditure Program Fund No. 100-54, Account No. 00ABAJ (Wonder View Trails Extension) as follows: Bureau of Engineering Fund No. 682-50, Account 50YVLE (Griffith Park ATP).

I FURTHER MOVE that the Bureau of Street Services, and the Bureau of Engineering be authorized to make any corrections, clarifications or revisions to the above fund transfer instructions, including any new instructions, in order to effectuate the intent of this Motion, and including any corrections and changes to fund or account numbers; said corrections / clarifications / changes may be made orally, electronically or by any other means.
