Comments for Public Posting: Good evening Councilmembers, my name is Veronica, I am a 25 year member of this community. I support the ICO and I ask you to do the same. The proposal to place an RV park in Mission Hills is reckless and harmful for our neighborhood. Health & Environmental Risks: There is potential for water contamination from waste and runoff. Odors from sewage and gas generators, which RVs must use even when parked, would impact our air quality. An RV park would also attract rodents and wildlife, which are already a challenge for our community. Safety Concerns: A school is only two blocks from the proposed site. As a parent, I would not feel safe allowing children to walk to and from school alone. This creates an additional burden for families without cars, or for children who currently walk independently. With the city already densified by ADUs, adding an RV park further stresses our evacuation routes. In a natural disaster, such as a wildfire, overcrowded streets could leave residents trapped, just like we saw in Pacific Palisades. Community Vision: Our city is investing in projects like Mission Mile to make Sepulveda Boulevard safer and more welcoming. An RV park five blocks away undermines those goals. This proposal does not reflect the vision we want for Mission Hills. I respectfully plead with you reconsider the RV park, and stand with the residents of Mission Hills. Support the ICO.
