

EXEMPTION FROM THE CALIFORNIA ENVIRONMENTAL QUALITY ACT (CEQA) PURSUANT TO CALIFORNIA CODE OF REGULATIONS, TITLE 14, SECTION 15060(C) (2) AND SECTION 15061(B)(3), and PLANNING AND LAND USE MANAGEMENT (PLUM) COMMITTEE REPORT relative to a proposed citywide Interim Control Ordinance regarding Recreational Vehicle Parks.

Recommendations for Council action:

1. ADOPT the proposed Recreational Vehicle Parks Interim Control Ordinance, Exhibit A and the Findings, Exhibit B, included in the Department of City Planning (DCP) report, dated September 23, 2025, attached to the Council file.
2. REQUEST the City Attorney to prepare and present the draft Interim Control Ordinance.

Fiscal Impact Statement: None submitted by the DCP. Neither the City Administrative Officer nor the Chief Legislative Analyst has completed a financial analysis of this report.

Summary:

At a special meeting held on September 30, 2025, the PLUM Committee considered a DCP report with recommendations, and a proposed citywide Interim Control Ordinance relative to Recreational Vehicle Parks.
