

TRANSPORTATION COMMITTEE REPORT relative to amending the Los Angeles Municipal Code to prohibit excessive storing of vehicles on local streets and to increase the penalties for violations.

Recommendation for Council action, pursuant to Motion (McOsker – Hutt):

REQUEST the City Attorney prepare and present an ordinance that amends Los Angeles Municipal Code Section 80.73.3 relative to storing vehicles in the street to expressly prohibit excessive reservation of public space and to make it a criminal violation subject to prosecution as a misdemeanor violation.

Fiscal Impact Statement: Neither the City Administrative Officer nor the Chief Legislative Analyst has completed a financial analysis of this report.

Community Impact Statement: None submitted.

Summary:

On August 13, 2025, your Transportation Committee considered a July 30, 2025 Motion (McOsker – Hutt) amending the Los Angeles Municipal Code to prohibit excessive storing of vehicles on local streets and to increase the penalties for violations. According to the Motion, maintaining the public right-of-way clear of obstruction is critical for emergency services and the clear flow of both vehicular and pedestrian traffic in our communities. After consideration and having provided an opportunity for public comment, the Committee moved to recommend approval of the Motion recommendation. This matter is now submitted to Council for its consideration.
