CATEGORICAL EXEMPTION and PUBLIC WORKS COMMITTEE REPORT relative to the renaming of Miner Street (Private) from 22nd Street (Private) to its southerly terminus, being established as Dave Arian Way (Private Street).

Recommendations for Council action:

- 1. FIND that the name establishment is exempt from the California Environmental Quality Act of 1970, pursuant to Article III, Class 5(4) of the City's Environmental Guidelines.
- 2. CHANGE and ESTABLISH the name of the private street, Miner Street (Private) from south of 22nd Street (Private) to its southerly terminus, as Dave Arian Way (Private Street).
- 3. INSTRUCT the City Clerk to transmit a copy of the Council action on this matter to the Board of Supervisors of the County of Los Angeles pursuant to Section No. 34092 of the California Government Code.

<u>Fiscal Impact Statement</u>: The City Engineer reports that a fee of \$4,628.82 was collected pursuant to Section 18.09 of the Los Angeles Municipal Code.
